1. Warm-Ups & Fundamentals

Embouchure AIR (woodWINDS & brassWINDS) Brass: Lip Slurs, WW: Octave Slurs Tonguing/Articulation Fingerings Bow Hold Bow Control - weight, speed, placement Slurs/Slurs Across Strings Bowing Styles Finger Placement & Shifting

2. Tone Quality

How long can you play in ONE breath? Play 4-measure phrases by default Lots of AIR - usually MORE AIR Use pinwheels to "see" the air Consistent tone from FROG to TIP Up to 8 beats in each bow Match bow directions/slurs

3. Tuning

Regularly, AFTER warming up Concert F & Bb DAILY - all 4 strings at the BEGINNING of class Beg: Teacher "pluck tunes" w/ method book Int: Students use tuner and/or play-along track Adv: Students tune from concertmaster's "A"

4. Transposition

Big PROBLEM! Circle of 4ths/Transposition Handout No Problem - an "A" is an "A" for ALL Does ALTO CLEF count???

5. Learning Fingerings, Note Names, and Rhythms

Flashcards Worksheets - Binders w/ sheet protectors & dry erase markers NinGenius App

6. Instrumentation / Balance

TUBA Clarinet Trombone Baritone/Euphonium French Horn Double Reeds Viola Bass

7. Large Instruments

Tuba, Baritone, Xylophone

Bass and Cello

8. Instrument Upgrades

Mouthpieces Reeds Strings Bows

9. Accessories Available in Your Room

Reeds - \$3 each Neck Straps (for school instruments) Gloves for Tuba (I like black) Valve Oil Trombone Slide Cream/Grease/Oil Tuning Slide Grease Cheap Shoulder Rests (search "angelico violins sp100 sponge") Shoulder Rest Bag (Uline.com) Violin/Viola Rosin Cello Rosin Bass Rosin

10. Instrument Repair

Use Rich Butler from Bert Murdock Music or find SOMEONE

11. Function Chorales

By Stephen Melillo - purchase as a PDF set of 22 chorales

12. Teacher Modeling

More effective than explaining or even singing Model on as many instruments as possible Use a section leader to model when needed Model difficult parts while ensemble is playing (on a LOUD instrument)

13. Achieving a More Mature Sound

Tone quality in all RANGES Tone quality at all DYNAMICS Sound Pyramid NO open strings Vibrato

14. Metronome

Dr. Beat MetroTimer App Drum Machine (Alesis SR-16 for \$149) MP3 tracks created by GarageBand More Cowbell!

15. Practice During Rehearsal

Sounds fine - do it ALL the time

Only for 30 seconds or less infrequently

16. Percussion

Two options: 1) separate percussion class or 2) mixed into band class Either way, use DRUM PADS *Remo 10" Tunable Practice Pad for \$30 Practice Pad Stand for \$50* Stagg Xylophones are a nice alternative to "bell kits" *Stagg Xylophone w/ stand: \$400, Yamaha Xylophone: \$1650* Use mallet flashcards & worksheets **The Percussionists Workbook** for multi-level pass-offs on all instruments *http://www.percussionwise.com/the-percussionists-workbook* **Hit it Hard!** for beginning percussion class *contact Paul Lemen: plemen@alpinedistrict.org*

18. Combined Songs

Like it pretty well Have to play SOFTER Learn to play sharps and naturals LOVE IT (even if just adding percussion) Have to play BIGGER Learn to play naturals and flats

19. Culture

Make it clear you equally LOVE both worlds Consider combining the two worlds into ONE PROGRAM *"Jaguar Music" instead of "Jaguar Band & Jaguar Orchestra"?* Have combined leadership team & activities
